

## **Eydon Conservation Area Appraisal (Draft for Consultation February 2012)**

South Northamptonshire Council is in the process of reviewing the Eydon Conservation Area and in October 2011 produced a draft Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Plan for the settlement. That document sets out the features that contribute to the distinctiveness of the area and identifies opportunities for its protection and enhancement.

Consultation on that draft document closed in December and following consideration of the representations received it has been decided to further amend the boundary of the proposed Conservation Area in two places.

These are:

1. The field to the west of Lime Avenue.
2. Land to south and east of Eydon Hall Farmhouse and Nos.1 and 2 The Green.

Comments are now being sought in respect to these further amendments which along with the original draft Conservation Area Appraisal are available for viewing on the Council's website at
