- Notes:**
- (1) The application should be made by a responsible officer of the Society (eg Chairman, Secretary or Treasurer) or by the person who will promote the lottery on their behalf.
 - (2) The Head Office or a local office of the Society must be in the Council's area.
 - (3) The purposes of the Society are as set out in its constitution. To be eligible for registration its purposes must be either charitable, sporting, recreational or cultural; or be other purposes which are not for private gain or any commercial undertaking.
 - (4) The offences covered under the declaration include those under Section 2, Section 13 or paragraph 14 of Schedule 1 of the Lotteries and Amusements Act, 1976; under Section 42, Section 45 or paragraph 12 of Schedule 7 of the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act, 1963; or offences involving fraud or dishonesty.
